






IT CAN HAPPEN TO ANYONE

80% of the total heat rise occurs in the 1st 30 min. Max temperatures can exceed **150°**

Interior vehicle temperatures



can be **50°** higher than outside

SAFETY TIPS

Never leave children unattended in a vehicle. NOT EVEN FOR A MINUTE!
Always check the backseat. Leave your wallet or purse as a reminder.
Always keep vehicle locked and keys out of reach.
Make arrangements with your childcare provider to call if child is absent.
CALL 9-1-1 if you see a child alone in a vehicle.
